

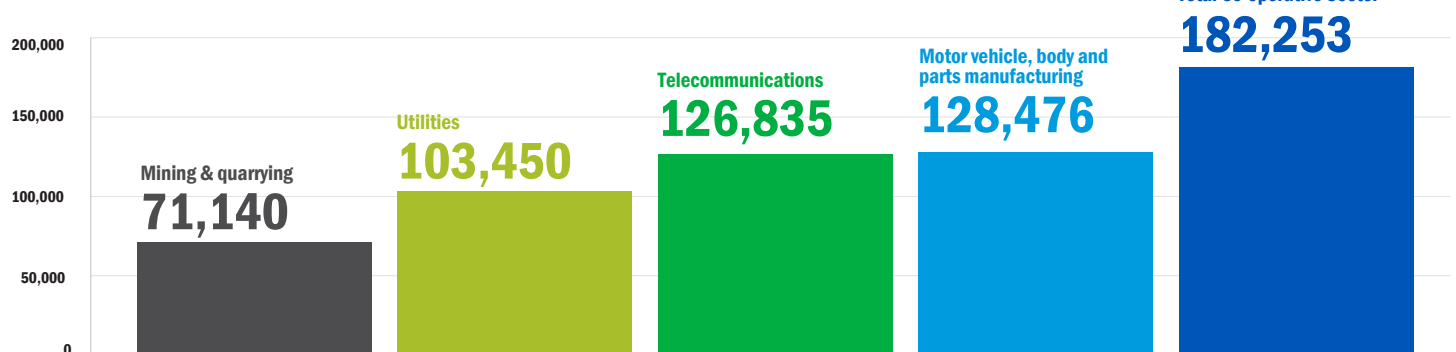

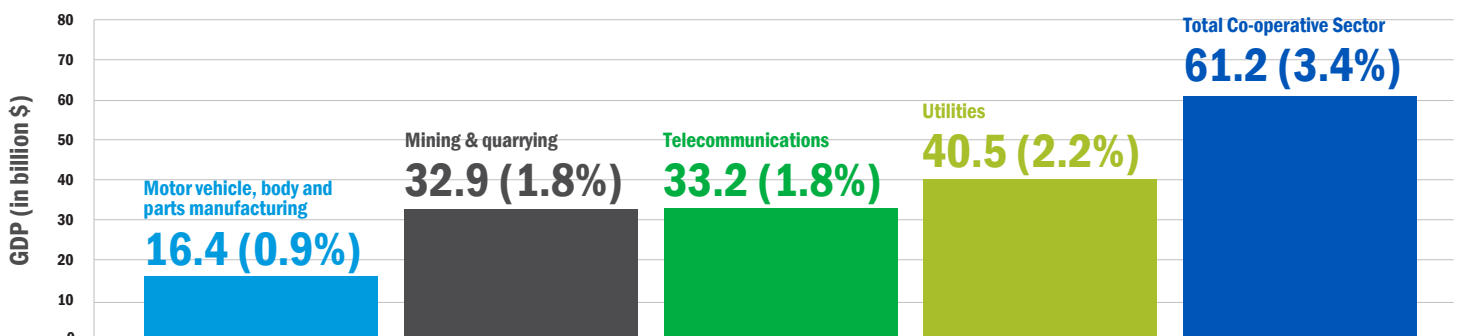
## Comparison of Jobs in the Co-operative Sector to Other Industries (2015)

All data comes from co-operatives that have submitted their annual survey to ISED Canada. Therefore, our study reflects the data from the 4,960 non-financial co-operatives that have reported to the ISED Canada survey. This is a 63% response rate. The data for financial co-operatives was obtained from the Canadian Credit Union Association (CCUA) and represents 100% of the financial co-operatives in Canada excluding Quebec. In Quebec, Desjardins Group is the only credit union; therefore, data pertaining to the credit union sector in Quebec was obtained from the Desjardins Group 2015 Annual Report. The 2015 data for the insurance co-operatives and mutuals was obtained from the International Co-operative and Mutual Insurance Federation (ICMIF).
