

Important Information Regarding Temporary Replacement Provisions under the CCA

The temporary suspension period (that included the emergency provisions under Emergency Order O. Reg. 107/20) now extends to December 31, 2021. This extension applies to sections 1, 3, 4, 6 and 7 of the Schedule to the Act. See the notice [here](#).

The following temporary replacement provisions are extended to December 31, 2021

- (1) Meeting by electronic means is extended
- (3) The suspension of in person voting is extended
- (4) Voting by electronic means is extended
- (6) Election of Directors by electronic means is extended
- (7) Electronic meetings for Boards and Executive committees is extended.

The ability to postpone your co-operative's AGM was NOT extended and the original deadlines still stand.

According to the original temporary replacement provisions: If the last possible date your AGM could be held, fell within the active state of emergency, you can postpone your AGM to a date within the 90 days following the final day of the state of emergency (October 22, 2020).

If the last possible date your AGM could be held, fell within 30 days after the state of emergency was declared over, you can postpone your AGM to a date within 120 days of the state of emergency being declared over (November 21, 2020).

The declared emergency was terminated on Friday July 24th, 2020 when the Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020 came into force (see s. 17: <https://www.ontario.ca/laws/statute/20r17#BK21>).
