Co-operative Young Leaders

CYL is a unique summer camp experience for youth ages 14-18. This series of week-long programming brings young people together from all across Ontario to learn about and practice the co-operative principles, as well as build communication and leadership skills through games, team-building exercises and participation in community projects.

Base Camp

Invites youth ages 12-13 to experience a weekend adventure and learn about the co-operative principles in an interactive, hands on way. Participants will enjoy the traditions of our CYL program and work on a project that incorporates their strengths, while working as a part of a team.
